Acting Out! Camp is a whole week of theatre fun! Students will explore a variety of theatre skills, including improvisation, movement, character exploration, and acting basics. Students will also rehearse a short, non-musical play, which they'll share with family and friends at the end of the week. All experience levels are welcome. Join us as we explore our imaginations and the world of theatre!

Broadway Camp: This one-week musical theatre camp is open to all experience levels. Along with theatre and improv games, students will sing, dance, and act as they work together to bring to life musical numbers from a popular musical. The class will end with a celebratory sharing for family and friends.

Musical Theatre Performance: Over the course of three weeks, students will experience the entire exciting process of putting up a musical: in-class "auditions," choreography, music, and staging rehearsals, tech rehearsal, and performance! All registered students will receive a role in the 30-minute end-of-camp show. This fast-paced class is for students with some musical theatre class or performing experience who are ready to work hard and have fun! The final week of camp and performances for invited guests will take place on the SLO REP stage.

Tech and Backstage Exploration: Are you interested in what goes on behind the curtain? This camp runs during concurrent the Musical Theatre Performance Showcase (session 2) and will explore the various technical operations that go on behind the scenes of a production. Students will have the opportunity to design and create the scenic, costume, prop, and lighting design for the Performance Showcase class, as well as acting as the backstage and tech crew for the end-of-camp performance on Friday, July 26.
